The project consisted of reconstruction of Dunteman Drive from Lake Ridge Drive to Bloomingdale Road (approximately 1600 lineal feet). Scope of work included roadway reconstruction, storm sewer improvements, new curb and gutter, sidewalk, and landscape restoration. Construction: October 2, 2012 to November 9, 2012	
The project consisted of roadway improvements to various residential streets located throughout the Village. Scope of work consisted of roadway resurfacing or reconstruction, storm sewer improvements, sidewalk and curb and gutter repairs and landscape restoration. Construction: June 2012 to November 2012	
The project consisted of construction of driveway entrance and parking lot reconstruction/addition for the Village Hall and Police Department buildings. In addition, the Aquatic Center drop off lane was reconfigured and the parking lot was resurfaced. Work included storm sewer improvements, lighting, landscape beautification and restoration. Construction: August 2011 to September 2012
