The existing right-of-way for Western Avenue was vacated and all new utilities (water main, sanitary sewer and storm sewer) were installed in the dedicated right-of-way. The reconfigured roadway was designed to accommodate future development along North Avenue. Construction of a 1.3 acre-foot detention pond was built adjacent to the roadway to facilitate storage and future development.</p> |
