Other Important Things to Know

Village Board of Elected Officials - The Village of Glendale Heights is divided into six different districts each represented by a District Trustee, and a Village President who oversees the entire Village. There is also a Village Clerk who maintains all official records for the Village. To find out who your District Trustee is, please visit www.glendaleheights.org or join them on the first Saturday of each month at the Center for Senior Citizens from 10:00 am to noon for Coffee and Chat with the Village President and Board.

Glendale Heights Police Department - The Village of Glendale Heights Police Department serves and protects all residents within the Village of Glendale Heights. Along with keeping residents and businesses safe, they also believe in Community Oriented Policing (C.O.P.) and working with the residents of Glendale Heights to help build trust and positive bonds. Fire and EMS - Fire protection and ambulance services are provided by the Glenside Fire Protection District and the Bloomingdale Fire Protection District, both are separate units of government and dependent on where you reside. Education - Elementary education is provided by Marquardt School District 15 and Queen Bee School District 16 depending on where you live. Secondary education is provided by Glenbard High School District 87. Glendale Heights also has a parochial school available.

Parks and Recreation - The Village of Glendale Heights does not have a separate taxing body park district. Instead, there is a Leisure Services Department. A program brochure is mailed out with a variety of activities for all ages. The Sports Hub features a variety of recreation programming from athletics, a fitness center, preschool classrooms, gymnasium, field house and more. There is also the GH₂O Aquatic Center directly next door to the Sports Hub open Memorial Day weekend to Labor Day weekend. For more information, please visit www.ghrec.org.
