Glendale Heights Police Department announces Labor Day Occupant Safety campaign results

Glendale Heights, IL – 4 seat belt citations were written during the Labor Day Occupant Safety campaign – 1 of which occurred during nighttime hours. Other citations and arrests included 12 speeding citations, 7 distracted driving citations, and 1 arrest for no driver's license.

“Through the Labor Day enforcement effort, we helped to make our roads safer and remind motorists that impaired driving is not a game,” said Sgt Chris Parsons.

The Glendale Heights Police Department joined forces with other law enforcement agencies and highway safety partners throughout the state for the Illinois Labor Day “Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over/Drive High. Get a DUI” enforcement campaign.
