

**NOTICE TO BIDDERS AND INVITATION FOR BIDS  
FOR THE  
PARK PARKING LOTS AND GLADSTONE PARK PATH IMPROVEMENTS**

**RECEIPT OF BIDS**

Sealed bids to complete all work required for the *Park Parking Lots and Gladstone Park Path Improvements* will be received by the Village of Glendale Heights, DuPage County, Illinois until 10:00 a.m. (Central Time) on July 25, 2017. Thereafter or as soon as thereafter is practicable, all bids received will be publicly opened and the bid prices read aloud. Sealed envelopes or packages containing bids shall be addressed to the Office of Purchasing, Glendale Heights Civic Center, 300 Civic Center Plaza, Glendale Heights, Illinois 60139, and shall be marked “Sealed Bid – *Park Parking Lots and Gladstone Park Path Improvements.*”

The work in general shall consist of pavement resurfacing, pavement reconstruction, hot-mix asphalt surface removal full depth, curb and gutter removal and replacement, P.C.C. sidewalk removal and replacement, hot-mix asphalt surface course, leveling binder, hot-mix asphalt binder course, aggregate base course, preparation of base, aggregate base repair, storm sewer improvements, pavement striping, landscape restoration, and all incidental and collateral work necessary to complete the project as shown on the plans and as described herein.

**CONTRACT DOCUMENTS**

This work shall be performed in accordance with the contract documents, copies of which are on file for review, and available for purchase at the Office of Purchasing, Glendale Heights Village Hall, 300 Civic Center Plaza, Glendale Heights, Illinois 60139. No payment is required to pick up a set of bidding documents. No bidding documents will be issued after 10:00 a.m. on July 25, 2017. All proposals must be submitted on the forms provided and in compliance with the Instructions to Bidders. Submission of a bid shall be conclusive assurance and warranty that the bidder has examined the plans, the site of the work and the local conditions affecting the contract and understands all of the requirements for performance of the work. The bidder will be responsible for all errors in its proposal resulting from failure or neglect to conduct an in-depth examination. The Village of Glendale Heights will in no case be responsible for any costs, expenses, losses or changes in anticipated profits resulting from such failure or neglect of the bidder. The bidder shall not take advantage of any errors or omission in the plans or proposal.

Minority and Women Owned Businesses (MBE/WBE) are encouraged to submit bids on this project.

**BID SECURITY**

Each bid shall be accompanied by a proposal guaranty in the form of a bid bond, executed by a corporate surety company, a bank cashier's check or a certified check payable to the Village of Glendale Heights for not less than five percent (5%) of the amount bid. The proposal guaranty checks of all, except the two lowest responsible bidders, will be returned after the proposals have been checked and tabulated. The proposal guaranty checks of the two lowest responsible bidders will be returned after the contract and the contract bond of the successful bidder have been properly executed and approved. Bid bonds will not be returned.

**RIGHT TO REJECT BIDS**

The Village of Glendale Heights reserves the right to waive technicalities and to reject any and all proposals for any reason deemed in the best interest of the Village of Glendale Heights.

**AWARD OF CONTRACT**

The Village of Glendale Heights reserves the right to award the contract to the lowest responsible Bidder for the BASE BID or for the BASE BID plus any or all ALTERNATES, based upon the Village's best financial interest. Each Bidder must submit bids for the BASE BID and all ALTERNATE(S) to be eligible for the award of the contract. Failure to do so will result in rejection of the CONTRACTOR's bid.

**The Village of Glendale Heights reserves the right to delete or amend quantities of any portion of the project if it is in the best interest of the Village to do so, including that of financial budgeting. Any portion deleted or amended from the contract shall have no bearing on the remaining work under the terms of this Contract or unit prices.**

**PAYMENT OF PREVAILING WAGES**

The general prevailing rate of wages in DuPage County for each craft or type of worker or mechanic needed to execute the contract or perform the work, also the general prevailing rate for legal holiday and overtime work, as ascertained by the Illinois Department of Labor, shall be paid for each craft or type of worker needed to execute the contract or to perform the work.
