BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
WEDNESDAY MAY 11, 2016

PRESENT: Commissioner Schwerdtner, Commissioner Macias

EXCUSED: Commissioner Wilk

ALSO PRESENT: Deputy Chief Ewoldt, Deputy Chief Oliver

Commissioner Schwerdtner called the meeting to order at 19:00 hours in the Floyd Brown Room. The minutes from April 13, 2016 were read. Motion Macias, second Schwerdtner to accept the minutes. Upon voice vote the motion passed unanimously.

**COMMUNICATIONS:** Memo to Chief Flint from Dpty Chief Ewoldt - notice of retirement effective Wednesday, June 8th. Motion Macias, second Schwerdtner to accept the retirement notice. Signed notice on file from Commissioner Wilk also accepting the retirement notice. Upon voice vote the motion passed unanimously.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:** Commission received approval to replace Officer Wendy Toigo. She has submitted retirement notice effective July 11, 2016. A reservation has been made at the July police academy so the commission will proceed with the testing/hiring process for one patrol officer. Commission has received approval for a new Sergeant from the village officer due to the promotion of Brandon Oliver to Dpty Chief. Next candidate on the Sergeant list is Michael Pentecost. The commission received a notice from the Chief that there has been no problems or issues with performance or fitness test with Officer Pentecost. Motion Macias, second Schwerdtner to promote Officer Pentecost to probationary Sergeant. Upon voice vote the motion was carried unanimously. Also on file - signed notice from Commissioner Wilk that she approves the promotion of Officer Pentecost. Promotion effective June 2nd and he will be sworn in at the village meeting on that day. Received request to remove candidate #58 Daniel Radovanovic. Motion Macias, second Schwerdtner to strike candidate from the eligibility list. Upon voice vote the motion passed unanimously. Most probationary officers doing well. There is still one that is behind and may have to have an extension on training. The commission adjourned to closed session at 19:30 hours. Returned to regular session at 19:35 hours. No action was taken in closed session. The commission will not be scheduling additional oral interviews at this time but has opted to retest candidate Santoyo as there was no conclusive results from his first polygraph (every question came back as inconclusive). Motion Macias, second Schwerdtner to allow a retest to make sure the problem was not the equipment. Upon voice vote, the motion passed unanimously. The commission administrative secretary will follow up with candidate Escobedo to check his status in the Chicago Academy and to confirm that he is still interested in continuing testing with Glendale Heights. Dpty Chief Ewoldt updated the commission as to the status of backgrounds and who will be finished soon should oral exams need to be scheduled.

**NEW BUSINESS:** New budget from the village board was submitted to commission, not much change from previous years plus the allowance for patrol officer candidate testing in fall 2016. Testing companies, dates, locations to be discussed at next meeting.

**PUBLIC QUESTIONS AND COMMENTS:** None

**GOOD OF THE COMMISSION:** Chairman Schwerdtner extended thanks and appreciation to Dpty Chief Ewoldt for his support of the commission and his support and service of Glendale Heights. Chairman Schwerdtner wished everyone a good memorial day and thanked all Veteran's who gave their life for our country.
