

VILLAGE OF GLENDALE HEIGHTS
BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
WEDNESDAY JUNE 8, 2016

PRESENT: Commissioner Schwerdtner, Commissioner Macias, Commissioner Wilk

ALSO PRESENT: Deputy Chief Oliver

Commissioner Schwerdtner called the meeting to order at 19:00 hours in the Floyd Brown Room. The minutes from May 11, 2016 were read. Motion Macias, second Wilk to accept the minutes. Upon voice vote the motion passed unanimously. Chairman Schwerdtner reviewed all minutes from Closed Sessions and informed the other commissioners that none of the minutes qualify to be released and made public.

COMMUNICATIONS: The commission received a notification from the Chief that he has received authorization from the Village Administrator to hire to probationary officers. The commission also received an Honorable Mention for Officer Parsons, badge #363. Police Consultants, Inc. sent a flyer asking to be considered for the upcoming testing.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: Report card received for probationary officer Hernandez from the academy and he is doing well. Probationary Officer Goodman submitted his resignation effective May 18th to Chief Flint who accepted it and in turn provided a copy to the commission. Motion Wilk, second Macias to accept Goodman's resignation. Upon voice vote the motion passed unanimously. Deputy Chief Oliver submitted a request from the Chief to promote probationary Sergeant Dave Baley to full time Sergeant effective June 4th upon successful completion of his probation. Chief Flint also requested that probationary officers Blondin and Noe be promoted to regular patrol officer effective June 18th upon successful completion of their probation. Motion Macias, second Wilk to approve these promotions. Upon voice vote the motion passed unanimously. Deputy Chief Oliver provided one new background to each commissioner for possible upcoming interview. Candidate #62 has not been responsive in keeping their phone number and other contact information updated and is not answering any inquiries from the department. Motion Wilk, second Macias to strike candidate #62 (Morriah Smith) from the eligibility list. No oral interviews were set; there are 2 candidates that can be moved to the psychological exam. Candidate Escobedo will not be moved on to psych until he graduates from the academy.

NEW BUSINESS: Election of Police Commission Officers: Motion Macias, second Wilk to keep positions as they currently are. All accepted their positions. Upon voice vote the motion passed unanimously. Deputy Chief Oliver will research what testing company administered patrol officer test two years ago and contact them regarding pricing and available testing dates. Deputy Chief Oliver will also talk to Glenbard North about using their facilities again for orientation and testing.
