Criminal Trespass to Residence

Glendale Heights, IL – On Tuesday, May 2nd at 4:27 pm the Glendale Heights Police Department responded to the 1000 block of Spruce St. for a Home Invasion. It was reported that four female subjects forced entry into an apartment in the area. One of the subjects displayed a taser/stun gun and the offenders attacked the resident and his guests before fleeing.

During the course of the investigation, the four suspects were located and taken into custody. Three of the suspects are juveniles and the fourth was identified as Glendale Heights resident Zuleydi Salgado, 20 years of age.

Zuleydi Salgado was charged with one count of Criminal Trespass to Residence. The other three were suspects were charged as juveniles. Salgado was transported to DuPage County Jail to await bond court.
