A bid bond, properly certified check, bank draft, cashier's check or letter of credit payable to the Village of Glendale Heights for not less than five (5) percent of the total bid amount will be required for each bid.

The Village of Glendale Heights will require the successful bidder to furnish a satisfactory performance and labor and material payment bond for the total contract amount of this project.

The general prevailing rate of wages in DuPage County for each craft or type of worker or mechanic needed to execute the contract or perform the work, also the general

prevailing rate for legal holiday and overtime work, as ascertained by the United States Department of Labor, shall be paid for each craft or type of worker needed to execute the contract or to perform the work.

No bids will be withdrawn without written consent of the President and Board of Trustees of Glendale Heights. The Village of Glendale Heights reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informality in the bidding.
