

CURBSIDE ELECTRONICS RECYCLING PROGRAM

Residents will be able to safely and securely recycle electronics curbside on your 2nd regularly scheduled collection day of the month *with at least one day prior notice to Republic* for no additional charge. Republic Services utilizes BlueGuard™ safety practices, which adhere to U.S. Department of Defense standards, to ensure that obsolete electronics are recycled safely, completely and responsibly.

In order to participate:

- Call Republic Services at (847) 981-0091 at least one day prior to your pick up day to schedule service.
- Electronic items should be kept separate from other items placed out for curbside pick-up.

- Digital Video Disc Players
- Digital Video Disc Recorders
- Electronic Keyboards
- Electronic Mice
- Facsimile Machines
- Monitors
- CD Players
- Printers
- Satellite Receivers
- Scanners
- Small Scale Servers
- Telephones (mobile and wired)
- Televisions
- VCR's
- Video Game Consoles
- Most other nonhazardous electronic items with a power cord or battery
