APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

A The meeting minutes of February 12, 2020 were read by the Commissioners. There are no changes to said minutes and Chairman Schwerdtner entertained a motion for approval.

Commissioner Macias moved to **approve the February 12, 2020 meeting minutes.** Chairperson Schwerdtner seconded this motion. Upon voice vote, the motion carried.

B No action or discussion at this time.

COMMUNICATIONS

A -Chairperson Schwerdtner received a copy of an Honorable Mention from Chief Flint for the following officers #238, #396, #3002, #318, #359, #357, #389 for an incident at Valley Produce on October 14, 2019 in which there was a report of an irate customer who possibly had a gun. The subject went into medical distress, CPR was administered and he was transported by Glenside FD.

-Chairperson Schwerdtner received a copy of an Honorable Mention for officer #386 for an incident on December 19, 2019 at 1591 Glen Ellyn Road in which he came upon a subject who was a suspect in an armed robbery in Glendale Heights, but also wanted on an outstanding warrant in Chicago. After consent was given for a search, a gun was located which was used in the armed robbery.

-Chairperson Schwerdtner received a copy of an Honorable Mention for officers #398, #399, #392, #3004 for an incident on December 21, 2019 at Glen Oaks Medical Center for an uncooperative patient.

-Chairperson Schwerdtner received a copy of an Honorable Mention for officers #238, #311, #381, #3003, #303, #387 for an incident on January 4, 2020 at 184 Gladstone for a suicidal subject. It was reported the subject had fired a gun into the floor, however, it was determined he did fire a gun into the ceiling. The upstairs residents were unharmed. During a search, the officers recovered 4 firearms and 5000 rounds of ammo. Felony charges were approved.
