Candidate #5 is scheduled for polygraph and psychological testing on November 16, 2022. Medical is scheduled for November 16, 2022. Names are due to the Academy on November 22, 2022 and the power test is December 13, 2022.

NEW BUSINESS

A. Deputy Chief Baley advised that the eligibility list is almost complete. We will open up applications in mid January with a test in February as we need a new list quickly. Chief Pappas asked for additional funding in the budget to cover advertisement and testing.

With the CMV enforcement that Officer Pugh is assigned to now, the revenue generated has allowed us to hire 2 extra officers to have in Problem Oriented Policing. There will be a unit of 2.

The department hopes to have the lateral movement figured out by the new year.

Names for the next academy are due to SWIC by March 17, 2023.
