A. Patrol Officer Written Test

Deputy Chief Pentecost advised that the written test for Patrol Officer would take place on Saturday, August 17, 2024. Orientation will take place at 9:00 am, the written test will begin at 10:00 am. As a reminder, the Sergeants written test will take place on September 5, 2024, and the assessment center will be done on September 17-18, 2024. Thus far there are 36 applicants for the Patrol Officer Test with applications due tomorrow. In looking at the candidates, there is alot of diversity. There are 9 scheduled to take the Sergeants Test.

To help with recruiting, we use joinghpd.org and have been posting videos of some of our newest officers. We also encourage applicants to do a ride along as well as attend the Citizen's Police Academy.
