- A.** Personnel Issues

Candidate Sanchez did not pass his medical. Another candidate will be discussed in Closed Session.

- B.** Probationary officer progress/status update

Deputy Chief Pentecost gave the following updates on the probationary officers:

- Officer Hoeksema is due to come off probation in June. He is doing well and there are no issues.
- Officers Zeitoun, Halipaj and Ramos are doing well and due to come off probation in October.
- Officer Cox is on solo patrol and doing well.

- Officer Caliendo is a good fit for nights and has taken on a leadership role. He will start assisting with training soon.
- Officer Farhatbegovic is a great fit.
- Officer Brinkley was moved from Observation to Solo Patrol.
- Officer Martin should be in Observation soon. He's doing ok, but he's young and has no police background at all.
- Officers Logan and Lansdell are set to graduate on April 25, 2025. They will spend 2 weeks in house and then start the field training program.
- We have no probationary Sergeants.
- There is 1 Sergeant on injury leave due to a back injury.

Commissioner Lux moved to adjourn and move to Closed Session. Commissioner Watts seconded this motion. **Upon voice vote, the motion was carried.** The meeting closed at 5:07 pm.

- A. Update Rules and Regulations - Preference Points for Police Cadets

Deputy Chief Pentecost advised the Commission that the department started a Cadet Program. Municipal Code allows for any person participating in the Cadet Program to get preference points. We would like the Rules and Regulations to reflect that small change. The request is to add under Section 7 "Police Explorer or Cadet points." Discussion took place and it was suggested to add the designation of "Glendale Heights" before Police Explorer and Cadet. The Rules and Regulations will be changed to reflect this and the items shall appear on the next meeting agenda under Old Business.


FUTURE MEETINGS
