Two Charged with Armed Robbery

Glendale Heights, IL – On 10/20/2016 at 6:06 PM officers from the Glendale Heights Police Department responded to the 500 block of Sidney Avenue for a report of an Armed Robbery. Officers identified one victim and learned two subjects approached him while he was on foot in the 500 block of Sidney Avenue and engaged him in conversation. One of the subjects produced a handgun and pointed it at the victim, demanding money and his cellular telephone. The victim complied and the offenders fled the scene on foot.

Glendale Heights Police Officers located two subjects on foot matching the description of the suspects provided by the victim. The subjects fled and were later apprehended by officers after a foot pursuit. The suspects were identified as Timothy Walls, 22 years of age, of St Charles, and Sayvon Jones, 23 years of age, of Lombard.

Jones and Walls were each charged with one count of Armed Robbery with a Firearm and transported to DuPage County Jail where they await a bond hearing.
